

Ex-N.Y. lawmaker jailed for marriage fraud

NEW YORK — A former New York state lawmaker was sentenced on Friday to a year and a day in prison for entering into a sham marriage to gain U.S. citizenship and for lying about her assets when filing for bankruptcy.

Gabriela Rosa, 47, represented a northern Manhattan district in the New York State Assembly before resigning and pleading guilty to federal charges in June.

A Dominican Republic native, she became a citizen in 2005. Only U.S. citizens can serve as New York state legislators.

During a sentencing hearing in Manhattan federal

court, U.S. District Judge Denise Cote scolded Rosa, her lawyer and people who wrote letters supporting leniency. Their arguments seemed to excuse what she did as typical of what all immigrants do, the judge said, according to a transcript.

Rosa's lawyer, Genesis Peduto, said at the hearing that Rosa was "following the American dream" and looking for a better life when she married someone to obtain citizenship.

The judge cut him off: "I am sorry. Are you suggesting that committing marriage fraud, which in this case meant paying \$8,000 to another person and lying to immigration officials for years, is the American dream?"

Peduto replied that was not what he meant, but Cote said later the argument was "a disservice to all our immigrants who actually try to follow the law and gain citizenship legitimately."

Prosecutors said Rosa paid \$8,000 to a U.S. citizen in 1996 and lied to immigration

authorities about the true nature of the relationship.

In 2009, prosecutors said, Rosa filed for bankruptcy but failed to disclose an apartment she owned, as well as outside income she received as a political consultant and income earned by her second husband.

Details emerge in La. teachers' suspected tryst with student

NEW ORLEANS — The elder of two female Louisiana teachers charged with having group sex with a 16-year-old student wooed her colleague and brought the boy to the younger woman's apartment on the night of the incident, according to a jail booking report.

Shelley Dufresne, 32, and Rachel Respass, 24, were arrested earlier this week on charges of having sex with the boy in Respass' residence in the New Orleans suburb of Kenner after a Friday night football game on Sept. 12.

The incident came to light after the boy bragged to classmates about it, authorities have said.

Both teachers had intercourse with the boy in Respass' apartment, according to the Jefferson Parish jail booking records, with Dufresne "intimately kissing (Respass) in an attempt to arouse all parties involved," as the boy and the younger teacher had sex.

Pa. jail guard accused of spying on naked inmates

PITTSBURGH — A western Pennsylvania jail guard is accused of using the facility's video surveillance system to spy on naked female inmates and will appear in court on invasion of privacy charges, authorities said on Friday.

State police say Daniel

Miller, 51, spied on at least four women who were showering at the Indiana County Jail between May and August, according to legal documents.

Miller is accused of training the surveillance system on the women, and the incidents were discovered when jail employees noticed the video was not

recording its assigned area.

He is charged with four counts of invasion of privacy.

Court administrators said he is slated to appear in the county's Magisterial District Court on Oct. 14 for a preliminary hearing.

Neither jail officials nor Pennsylvania State Police could be reached immediately for comment.

Former Austria forward jailed over match-fixing

VIENNA (Reuters) — Former Austria forward Sanel Kuljic was sentenced to five years' in prison on Friday for his part in the country's biggest-ever match-fixing scandal.

Dominique Taboga, a former league player, was given three years, two of them suspended, and six other people were also given custodial sentences

by the court in Graz, the Austria News Agency (APA) said, while two defendants were acquitted.

The sentences can be appealed.

Kuljic, who retired as a player in 2012, played for Austria 20 times between 2005 and 2007, but failed to make the cut for the Euro 2008 squad.

Milwaukee man pleads guilty in Stradivarius violin theft

MILWAUKEE — A Milwaukee man accused of stealing a 300-year-old Stradivarius violin from a concert musician pleaded guilty on Friday to felony robbery, circuit court records show.

Salah Jones, 42, faces up to 15 years in prison after pleading guilty in Milwaukee County Circuit Court to stealing the violin, valued at about \$5 million.

Jones was accused of using a stun gun to incapacitate concert musician Frank Almond as he left a concert in a Milwaukee suburb on Jan. 27 and taking the violin, made in 1715, according to prosecu-

tors.

Jones told a witness that stealing a Stradivarius violin "was his dream theft" because of its potential value, the criminal complaint said.

Authorities recovered the instrument — undamaged, inside a suitcase — in the attic of a Milwaukee home nine days after the theft.

The so-called Lipinski Stradivarius had been on loan indefinitely to Almond from a private owner. It is one of roughly 600 violins, violas and cellos still in existence that were built by the famed Italian artisan Antonio Stradivari.
